

Oops! That Was Me

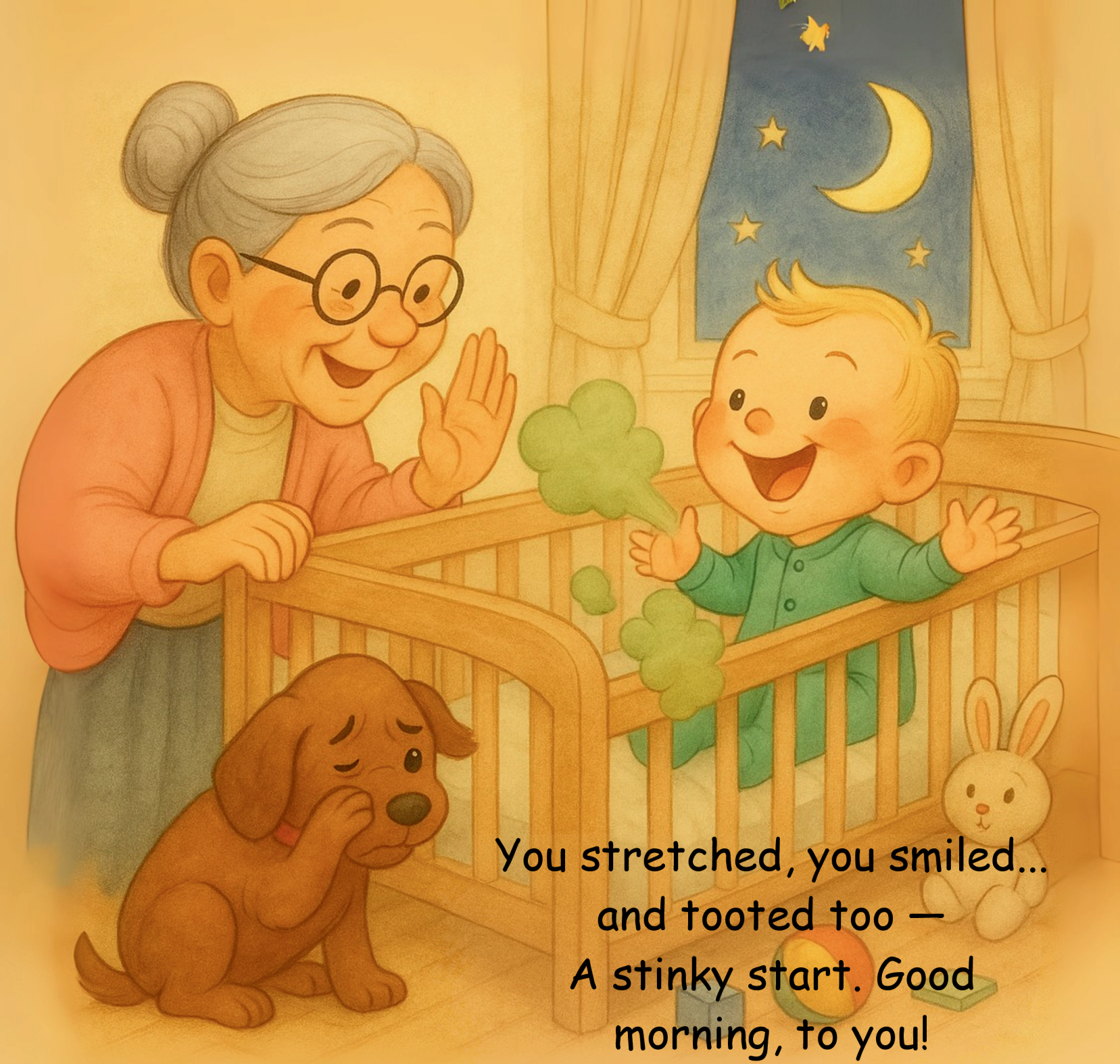
